Well what have we been doing?

Dear Ridgeback Lover

Fortunately the fear that we would be inundated with Rescues as a result of lockdown pups didn't materialise although, throughout this year, we were asked on several occasions to help with behavioural problems. Some of these were to be expected, with inexperienced owners and boisterous Ridgebacks, and as a result of owners returning to work after lockdown suggesting a lack of socialisation and perhaps separation anxieties as owners resume their lives somewhat.

So far this year we've had 34 surrender enquiries, where documents were sent out, resulting in 20 dogs being surrendered, 8 Female and 12 Male. 19 of these have

been re-homed with one pending. The age range has been between 1 and 9 years with an average age of 4+ years. We are ever grateful to all the amazing people willing to adopt a dog, often a less than perfect Ridgeback, that may take a lot of hard work, training and

understanding to become a sociable member of the family.

Happily, we have been able to hold our two major events in 2022, both of which have been a great success. Sunday 3rd July saw some 80 people and 50 dogs gather in Chieveley, near Newbury for a day of fun, games and frolics seeing old friends and new and in all, over £900.00 was raised for RRWT. Our thanks to everyone that attended and to the committee of the Southern Rhodesian Ridgeback Association (SRRA) for their wonderful support for the event. Special thanks to Liz and Paul Storey, our constant supporters, for their donation of a case of wine for raffle, which raised £175.00.




